There will be an expectation to show creativity and initiative. The team commit to being supportive of one another and will always looks for ways to serve each other.

As Guildford Youth Pastor your focus will be support the Youth team in seeing this vision outworked is these 4 areas.

Culture

Programme

- Contribute to wider church events that include Under18s, including Wildfires etc.

- Recruit, equip and support a team of volunteers to support the youth work.
- Work within Emmaus Rd's safeguarding policy.
- Support with the implementation of the Safeguarding Policy
- Induct all volunteers with the onboarding procedure

Church Life

- Make Emmaus Rd Guildford your home.
- Build and maintain relationships with parents and carers of young people in Emmaus Rd Guildford and help families integrate into the life of the church.

Role Responsibilities

Your role will be to Lead the 10-18 year olds at Emmaus Rd Church Guildford.

Discipleship

<u>On Sunday</u>

- Lead the Youth Work in our Guildford Congregation
- Work with the Guildford Kids Pastor in overseeing the Sunday Routine
- Be a part of the Guildford Staff Team representing the Youth work
- Work with the leadership on any extracurricular Sunday activities such as Christmas carol services, all age services and after church activities and post church socials
- Manage and grow the Sunday Youth provision.

<u>Midweek</u>

- Support the Head of Youth in Implementing a mentoring structure thought-out Emmaus Rd Regionally
 - Mentor young people.
 - Supporting the various other youth discipleship groups and activities where reasonably required, including trips, events etc.
 - Oversee Our Midweek Collective Program including team, teaching and admin.
 - Co lead with the other town Youth Pastors our monthly worship and prayer evenings

Outreach

- Develop our schools work, including mentoring, assemblies, prayer spaces in schools etc.
- Supporting/Leading the other various youth outreach projects and partnership oppurtunties where reasonably required (Untamed, Guildford Alpha etc).

Events

- Work closely and take a leading role in whatever residential trips we may run for the young people
- Co lead and run Light night parties, Summer Parties, Christmas parties and more

Other responsibilities and activities

- Attending the annual Wildfires church holiday and serving on team as required.
- Taking part in Youth team meetings.
- Attending Emmaus Rd/24-7 team meetings as required.
- Support the Head of Youths Ministry as needed.
- Attend the termly Family Business meeting
